



# 2018 CRKN AGM: Vancouver, October 16-18, 2018 Overall and session evaluation report, day one

How relevant were today's sessions to you/your work?











## Please rate your satisfaction with the level of detail in today's sessions.



#### Was the level of interacrion during today's sessions appropriate?










Please rate your overall level of satisfaction with today's sessions.



## Themes based on respondent comments

#### Keynote

- Including scholars from outside of the library field in the AGM was appreciated
- The panel's expertise was noticed
- Highly relevant to the library field but included different perspective
- Some noted that the talk didn't tie in as well with the other sessions as it could have
- Some noted that the talk should have been alotted more time in the agenda

## **Canadiana Update**

- Information provided clarity and a better understanding of Canadiana
- There was some information on metadata and subject issues related to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission that could have been added or improved upon
- There is still some uncertainty about the roles of Canadiana vs. NHDS

- The fact that the sessions were bilingual and offered translation was a highlight



## How relevant were today's sessions to your work?







## Was the level of interaction during today's sessions appropriate?









Please rate your overall satisfaction with the location of the event.










## Please rate your overall satisfaction with the simultaneous translation.










Please rate your overall satisfaction with the Simon Fraser University Library tour.










Please rate your overall satisfaction with the University of British Columbia Library tour.











Please rate your overall satisfaction with the balance between programming and networking.


