CRL's open web repository promotes transparency and accountability by providing a permanent public record of government documentation that defines the rights and obligations of citizens and records the activities of government. CRL is digitizing official gazettes from its extensive collection of print and microfilm, and will augment these materials by harvesting from the web more recent gazettes and related data published digitally.

The South Asia Open Archives (SAOA) invites researchers to explore its openly accessible collection of research materials from and about South Asia. SAOA is an initiative of a broad consortium of research libraries and their respective South Asian Studies librarians, with substantial contributions of content, and human and material resources. Affiliated with the [South Asia Materials Project](#), administratively hosted by the [Center for Research Libraries](#) (CRL), and presented for open access online via a partnership with JSTOR/Ithaka, SAOA is a curated collection of digitized materials from across the region, spanning a variety of subjects and languages. Current collection development priorities highlight resources related to themes of caste & social structure, literature, social & economic history, and women & gender, covering a wide spectrum of types, including monographs, periodicals, and governmental reports. 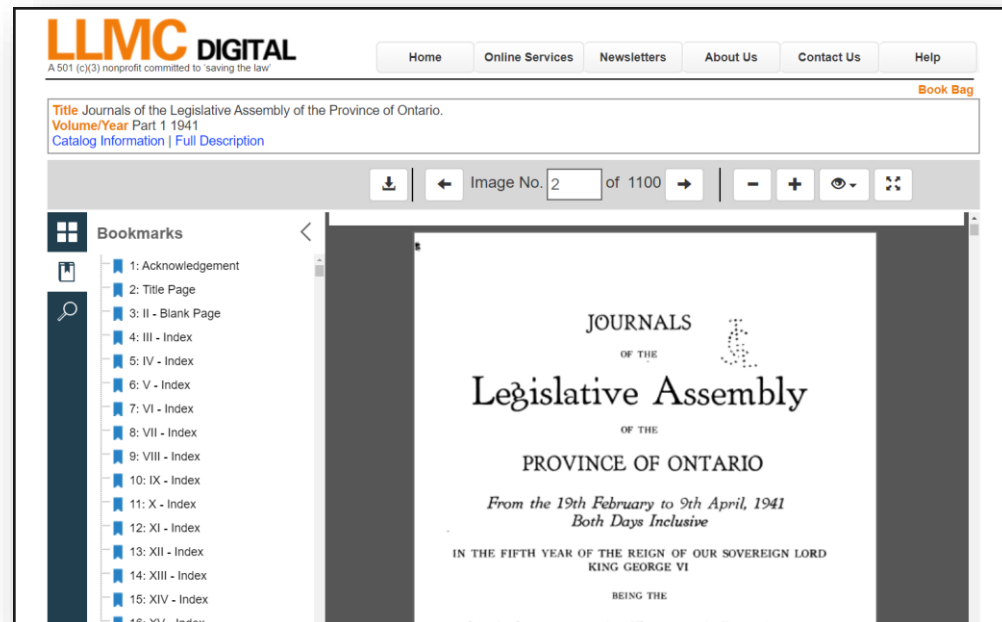

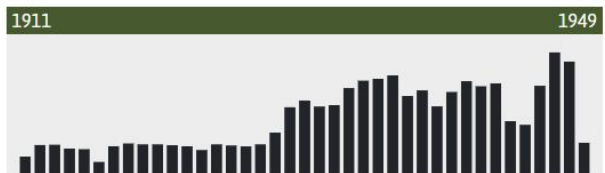

The first half of the twentieth century began with the demise of China's last imperial dynasty, the Great Qing, and ended with the foundation of the People's Republic of China in October 1949. Following the 1912 establishment of China's first post-imperial government, the Republic of China, the country experienced both industrial and social revolution, a civil war during which communist and nationalist forces battled to shape the country's future, and looming external threats during both world wars.
