The CSC has responsibility for guiding CRKN's licensing and open access programs, including undertaking negotiations with publishers, setting strategies and objectives for renewals, and developing principles and guidelines that govern CRKN's activities in the scholarly communications arena.

#### Multiple Pathways to Open Access

- Partnership Models for Open Access Publishing
  - o Coalition Publica, SCOAP3, OA2020, SCOSS, PLOS
- Green Open Access (deposit in institutional or disciplinary repositories)
- Transformative Agreements
- Lowering cost of Article Processing Charges (APCs)
- Reducing cost of commercial subscription agreements
- Developing criteria to assess and prioritize opportunities to invest in OA projects and publishing models outside of traditional licensing program









#### The Annual Cost of the Subscription Model (2022)

Elsevier: \$31.7 Million US

Wiley: \$15.3 Million US

Taylor & Francis: \$10.6 Million US

Springer Nature: \$10.1 Million US

SAGE: \$5.5 Million US (TA)

American Chemical Society: \$3.8 Million US

Oxford University Press: \$3.2 Million US

Cambridge University Press: \$2 Million US (TA)

Institute of Physics: \$1.8 Million US (TA)


Royal Society of Chemistry: \$800k US (converted from GBP)

Canadian Science Publishing: \$600k US (converted from CAD)

TOTAL: US \$85.4 Million / CA \$109.3 Million

### Transformative Agreements

- "Transformative agreement" is an umbrella term describing those agreements negotiated between institutions (libraries, national and regional consortia) and publishers in which former subscription expenditures are repurposed to support open access publishing, thus transforming the business model underlying scholarly journal publishing, gradually and definitively shifting from one based on toll access (subscription) to one in which publishers are remunerated a fair price for their open access publishing services.

#### **CRKN-SAGE** Agreement

- Legacy SAGE License
  - Subscription agreement in place 2007-2020
  - 40% APC discount negotiated for 2018-2020 (both hybrid and gold)
  - Subscription cost in 2020: US\$ 5.3 Million
- Transformative agreement in place for 2021-2023
  - APCs waived for all hybrid journal articles published by CRKN-affiliated corresponding authors
  - 40% APC discount remains for Gold OA journals
  - Cost in 2021: US\$ 5.5 Million (1 large institution joined license, accounting for increase in cost)
  - 3% increase in 2022 and 2023








#### 2021 Hybrid Articles - OA Status





### **CRKN-Cambridge Agreement**

- Legacy CUP License
  - Subscription agreement in place 2007-2021
  - 20% APC discount negotiated for 2019-2021 (both hybrid and gold)
  - Subscription cost in 2021: US\$ 1.9 Million
- Transformative agreement in place for 2022-2024
  - APCs waived for all hybrid and gold journal articles published by CRKNaffiliated corresponding authors
  - Cost in 2022: US\$ 2 Million
  - Added US \$47,000; 3-year average of non-funded APCs paid by authors
  - 0% increase in 2022
  - 1% increase in 2023 and 2024



#### 2020 Publication Output (All CRKN Members)



  - Subscription agreement in place 2001-2021
  - Subscription cost in 2021: US\$ 1.65 Million
- Transformative agreement in place for 2022-2024
  - APCs waived for all hybrid and gold journal articles published by CRKNaffiliated corresponding authors
  - Cost in 2022: US\$ 1.77 Million
  - 4% increase in 2022
  - 2% increase in 2023 and 2024
