

Findings

- 1. People are publishing more than just traditional scholarly books, and creating fit-for-purpose publishing workflows
- 2. People want to **better leverage open infrastructures** & other good practices regarding metadata, dissemination and persistent identifiers
- 3. Most people publishing books & other long form content are **also publishing journals**
- 4. Book & other experimental, long form publishing stil has enormous **untapped potential** to enrich our collective knowledge


